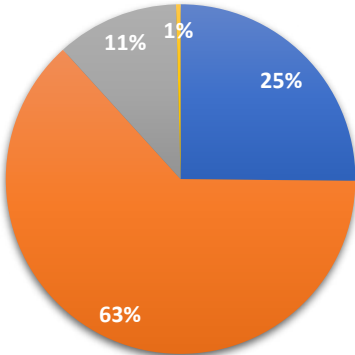

REVENUE AND EXPENSES

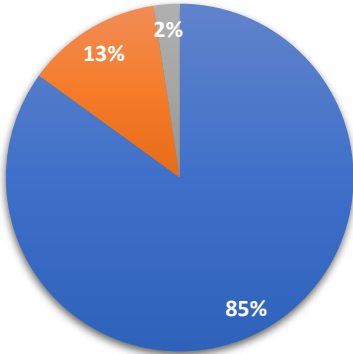

FOR OVER 170 YEARS Marygrove has been a place where children, youth and families in need have found hope and healing. Marygrove provides treatment and support to young people struggling with physical, sexual and emotional abuse, neglect, abandonment and other trauma. As one of the only organizations in the St. Louis metro area to provide a comprehensive continuum of residential and community based programs, Marygrove transforms over 1,000 young lives each year.

MARYGROVE PROVIDES a full range of behavioral health services including:

• **Therapeutic Residential Treatment:**

Residential and Intensive Treatment “cottages” provide a safe and stable living environment while youth receive help to manage emotional and behavioral issues.

• **Therapeutic Foster Care:**

Community based foster homes where children learn to trust and engage positively in a family setting.

• **Transitional Living Program:**

On-campus psychiatric group homes provide a foundation of support as young adults pursue academic, occupational and other life skills that advance them toward healthy and productive adult lives.

• **Independent Living Program:**

A community based, scattered site apartment program where young people, including teen parents, learn important skills which move them toward self-sufficiency.

• **Crisis Services:**

A full range of shelter services that provide a safe and nurturing environment for youth experiencing homelessness or family crisis for a period of up to 30 days.

• **The Marygrove School:**

An on-campus, private special education school for children who require more therapeutic support during the school day.
