

Foster Care Parent – Therapeutic Foster Home

Purpose and Objective of the Position

The Foster Parent supervises and runs the daily activities of therapeutic foster home. This includes being responsible on a 24-hour basis for the care, supervision, and safety of up to 2 children.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities of the Position

- 1. Assumes the primary responsibility for the care and supervision of the children in foster home
- 2. Assumes the primary responsibility for the resident's, transportation to school, medical appointments, dental appointments, and any/all appointments necessary for the adequate care of the children in their care
- 3. Provides adequately for the health and safety of residents
- 4. Maintains the home so that it is clean, orderly, and safe at all times
- 5. Attends the treatment reviews of the resident
- 6. Responsible for the daily planning and interactions with the residents and implementing children's treatment plans.
- 7. Participates in staff training as mandated
- 8. Maintains compliance with all agency standards and policies
- 9. Help the organization meet its quality improvement, evaluation, and reporting requirements by contributing to developing outcomes,
- 10. Performs other duties assigned by the Assistant Director of Foster Care.
